### **SMART Survey Overview**

The Simple, Meaningful, Accessible, Reliable, and Timely (SMART) Survey is an instrument the Religious Freedom Institute has deployed in select countries, including some of those on which the Freedom of Religious Institutions in Society (FORIS) <u>Project</u> is focused.

The SMART Survey disaggregates religious freedom into two dimensions: (1) the free exercise of religion and (2) religious equality or nondiscrimination. It further disaggregates each of these dimensions into (1) individual and (2) institutional sub-dimensions. The SMART Survey then provides an additional layer of analysis; i.e., from the perspective of the majority faith community or a minority religious community in a given country.

Respondents consist of scholars, legal experts, religious leaders, and others with a deep understanding of the constitutional, legislative, political, and administrative (regulations and enforcement) realities that affect religious liberty in the countries for which they are completing a survey. They also possess in-depth knowledge of non-state, social actors that influence religious freedom conditions in those countries.

The SMART Survey is designed to collect detailed data on both the type and intensity of religious restrictions. Respondents are asked to identify and assess constitutional restrictions, legislative restrictions, political or law enforcement restrictions, and social restrictions. Respondents are also prompted to rate the intensity of each type of restriction using a numerical scale. Importantly for the FORIS Project, as the survey progresses, questions are sorted along two key dimensions of religious restrictions: those enforced against *individuals* (e.g., restrictions on freedom of belief, exit, conversion, individual practice, etc.) and those enforced against *institutions* (e.g., restrictions on independence of religious organizations, property rights, access to legal personality, etc.).
